**Re: Amended Directive 76/769/EEC
Lampoil clear, grill liquid, torch oil**

As announced in our letter of 30th October 2009, above mentioned amendment means:

lamp oils, labelled with R65 or H304, intended for supply to the general public are visibly, legibly and indelibly marked as follows: “Keep lamps filled with this liquid out of the reach of children”; and, by 1 December 2010, “Just a sip of lamp oil — or even sucking the wick of lamps — may lead to life-threatening lung damage”

torch oils, labelled with R65 or H304, intended for supply to the general public are visibly, legibly and indelibly marked as follows: “Keep torches filled with this liquid out of the reach of children”; and, by 1 December 2010, “Just a sip of torch oil — or even sucking the wick of torches — may lead to life-threatening lung damage”

grill lighter fluids, labelled with R65 or H304, intended for supply to the general public are legibly and indelibly marked by 1 December 2010 as follows: “Just a sip of grill lighter may lead to life-threatening lung damage”

lamp oils and grill lighters, labelled with R65 or H304, intended for supply to the general public are packaged in black opaque containers not exceeding 1 litre by 1 December 2010.

2, 3 and 5L cans may not be sold anymore to the” general public”, but if you are selling these bottles/cans to “professional users”, than you may keep on selling these products. We do advise you though to add the sentence “only for professional use” on the label of the 2, 3 and 5L.

“THE OLD DUTCH FARMLIGHT” lampoil clear, grill liquid and torchoil will be delivered in black bottles with adapted label PER 1ST JANUARY 2010!

As per 1st of December 2010, only black bottles with adapted labels may be sold in the shops. It is very important, that you urge your customers and/or your shops that from now on, they have to work absolutely according the “First in, First out” system, so all the clear bottles will be sold per 1st December 2010! Sel Chemie will not take back any old stocks!

In the transitional period we will close the boxes of the black bottles with black tape, so in the warehouse the difference between clear and black bottles can be easily seen.

As far as the new legislation of GHS-CLP is concerned, we will come back to this as soon as possible. Because the registration of chemicals is not yet finished, we cannot make all changes at the same time. For this change there is, however, a transitional period of two years, if the bottles are not produced later than 1st December 2010.
